What are ESY Services?

- Special education services
- And/or related services
- Uniquely designed to provide
- A Free and Appropriate Public Education or FAPE
- To eligible students with disabilities

Extended School Year



What Makes ESY Services Unique?

ESY services are provided beyond the normal school year

- More Days
- More Hours



IS ESY LIKE SUMMER SCHOOL?

Summer School

- Designed for all students
- Teaches new skills
- Helps students catch on and catch up

ESY

- Designed for students with disabilities
- Teaches previously learned skills
 Prevents students from falling further behind



How Does ESY Help?

- Retains skills previously learned
- Fully masters recently learned skills
- Does not lose time re-learning skills
- Does not miss a unique window of opportunity



Why Not Just Go to Summer School?

- Skilled instructors
- Familiar with the IEP
- Specialized instruction
- Adaptations
- Modifications
- Behavior intervention




Why not just create year-round learning opportunities?

- Could be Beneficial
- Not Yet Required
- Also is Expensive



Will ESY Help a Student Make AYP?

- Performance
- Rate of Progress
- Regression
- Recoupment



ESY VS. SUMMER SCHOOL

Kids in summer school and ESY may

- Go to the same school
- At the same time
- Spend time together each day
- Take part in joint activities

Teaching Familiar Skills VS. New Skills

- If time permits can't we do both?
- Why isn't catching up as important as not falling farther behind?
- Isn't the team supposed to help my child reach his goals?

ESY vs. Child Care

When I came to observe I noticed that . . .

- The ESY staff didn't have a current IEP to follow
- The "snap shot" information was inaccurate and created without my input.
- The staff were not trained to use his technology or implement his behavior plan.

- Addresses recoupment
- Not childcare, summer school or respite care
- Required for some children to benefit from education.
